**To Graduate:**

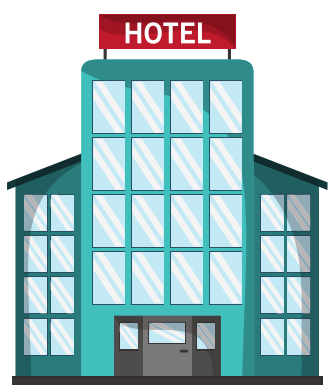
- Pass all courses with **GPA 2.0**

## SEMESTER 2

### REGISTRATION

- Make sure you are registered for semester 3 on time
- You should have your Co-op Work Permit on hand at this time
- Upload your **Co-op Work Permit** in the co-op course on Schoology



## SEMESTER 4

Attend each and every class starting from week 1

### WEEK 1 - 6

- Continue applying for placement opportunities
- Confirm co-op and upload approval documents on Schoology **OR**
- Complete and upload capstone documents on Schoology

### WEEK 3 - 4

You should start applying immediately for your **Co-op Work Permit**. To apply, you will need:

- Most recent Letter of Acceptance (**LOA**) **OR** Most recent enrollment Letter (**ask SSD**)
- Co-op Work Permit Request Letter (**ask Placement Coordinator**)
- Book appointment with Hanson immigration consultant, personal consultant or apply by yourself.
- Ensure your work & study permits are designated for Hanson or Cambrian College

## SEMESTER 3

Check if you passed all courses in semester 1 & 2 and achieved **GPA 2.0**

### REGISTRATION

- Start applying for placement opportunities **OR**
- Complete and upload capstone documents on Schoology
