SEMESTER 2

REGISTRATION

- Make sure you are registered for semester 3 on time.
- You should have your Co-op Work Permit on hand at this time.
- Send Co-op Work Permit to your Placement Coordinator.

WEEK 1

- Have a well written resume and cover letter and be prepared for co-op job interviews.
- Have a professional email address and LinkedIn profile.
- Start applying for Co-op opportunities.

WEEK 13 - 16

- Confirm co-op and upload approval documents on Schoology.

REGISTRATION

- Make sure you are registered for semester 3 on time.

SEMESTER 4

- Check if you passed all courses in semester 3 and achieved **GPA 2.0**

WEEK 1 - 14

- Have fun acquiring work experience from your Co-op!

- Post your Co-op assignments to Schoology for review, this is a Pass/Fail course.

WEEK 3 - 4

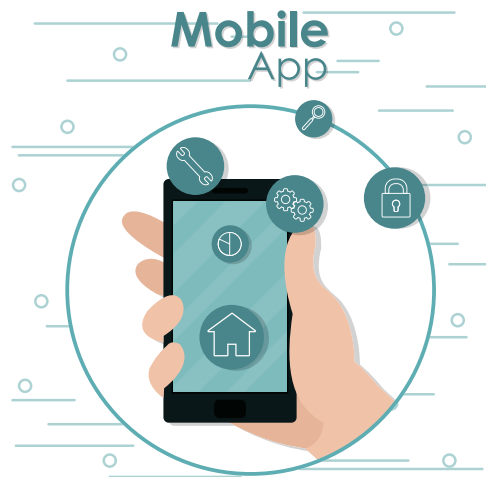
You should start applying immediately for your **Co-op Work Permit**.

- Book appointment with Hanson's Immigration Consultant, your personal consultant or apply by yourself.
- Ensure your work & study permits are designated for Hanson or Cambrian College.
